

From Peru to Newtownabbey – a journey of faith Yury Fleming's story

Born into a small town in the highlands of Peru, I was brought up by my mum as my father left us as soon as he found out my mum was expecting. Life was difficult but my mum worked hard as a teacher to maintain us. She heard the word of God through missionaries from here and came to know the Lord. It always amazes me the sacrifices made by these people in leaving their home and travelling round the world to bring the Good News to a small town like mine.

My mum had to overcome rejection of first being unmarried and then the only Christian in a nominally Catholic home. She won over her family with her life which was my great example. My mum took me to church and I thought that made me right with God. She also took me to Christian Camps where we met other church families and had so much fun. I was taught about a Heavenly Father who loved me, who would never abandon me, who cared for me in a way my biological father never had, something I always struggled with and could not address with my mum for the pain it caused her.

I clearly remember one night hearing a sermon about having a personal relationship with God and I realised I was not right with God. The missionary told us that unless we take the decision to trust Jesus as our Lord and ask for forgiveness, surrendering our life into His hands, God was not in us. This shocked me and I wanted to understand more. I went to speak with the missionary that night, at eleven years of age. He happily spoke to me from his Bible, God's word, which was much worn and cherished. He explained it is God, the Lord of creation, who controls our lives, even though we may think we do. God knew my father would abandon us. It was not controlled by my father, God meant it



for good and although then I could not understand, now I can see God's hand in my life. That same night, in January 1989, I asked God to change my life, no longer my will but His to rule. My life changed! God now was there for me in all things and though the Devil attacked me even more, in many different areas of my life, and I failed God so many times, He was faithful to forgive me when I came to Him. He has promised never to leave me or forsake me. What a promise!

I have had the privilege of working with street children in Peru and young people here and had many experiences in life to help me understand others who are going through similar situations. My mum married a Godly man and I had the privilege of being adopted and learning so much from his love of God. I have received rich blessings. The road has not been easy but, praise the Lord, I have a Heavenly father who loves me and will never leave me or let me down! Amen.
